The same information should be available in all versions of the journal.</li> <li>• The Author Guidelines should require authors to sign up for ORCID's, and to provide these to the journal for each author at the time of article submission. More about ORCID's here <a href="https://orcid.org/">https://orcid.org/</a></li> <li>• The Author Guidelines should request authors to declare any conflicts of interest as well as details of the origin of any research</li> </ul>

Members should not all be from the same institution.</li> <li>• The country where each Advisory Committee and any other Committee or Panel Member is based should be listed with their affiliations. Advisory Committee Members should be geographically diverse (not all from the same country).</li> </ul>
Other items	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The journal needs to set up an archival digital preservation arrangement with an external organisation, such as LOCKSS or Portico.</li> <li>• The journal must begin regularly loading its own content to the JOL platform to be considered for a higher JPPS Star level.</li> <li>• The journal is encouraged to display article level metrics (such as full text download numbers) on the JOL and on its own website.</li> </ul>
